<u>Small Group Leaders' Handbook (IVP).</u> This guide contains everything you need to know about small groups: foundation, key components, prayer and worship, evangelism, leadership, and more!

<u>The Willow Creek Guide to Leading Life-Changing Small Groups (Zondervan).</u> Bill Donahue provides a comprehensive reference to help leaders and managers look at group formation, leadership requirements and training, and discipleship within groups.

<u>The Big Book on Small Groups (IVP).</u> Jeffrey Arnold discusses the basic components and dynamics of small groups and describes how to develop relationships within the group, how to train group leaders, and much more.

<u>Turning Committees into Communities (NavPress).</u> Roberta Hestenes clarifies that caring isn't optional, even in task groups. Find out how to get things done and have a heart for each other, too.

How to Ask Great Questions (NavPress). Karen Lee-Thorp helps you design and ask questions to prompt good thinking and life application.

<u>Building a Church of Small Groups (Zondervan).</u> Bill Donahue and Russ Robinson provide leaders with the vision, values, and steps necessary to begin building a church where small groups are integrated throughout a church's entire ministry.

<u>The Connecting Church (Zondervan).</u> Randy Frazee challenges us to reclaim the kind of love, support, and spiritual growth that first century Christians experienced! - e) And if you are leading a group study, never just read the questions. Reframe the questions (and be selective) so that you are comfortable asking the questions. Make the questions your own!
